ADMISSIONS

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

In admitting children to Pre-K and Kindergarten, candidates must meet the age requirements of the local school district in which the child resides. Please check with your local school district for age requirements.

Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis and must include copies of birth and baptismal (if applicable) certificates and immunization records. All students applying for admission to OLSS are required to be immunized. In addition, applications for students entering Grades 1-8 must include academic and behavioral records, standardized test scores, and Child Study Team evaluations (if applicable).

Completed applications are reviewed by the principal, and parents will receive a letter confirming their child's enrollment status at OLSS. As part of the enrollment process, a meeting with the student, parent and the school administration may be required prior to acceptance.
